#### PREPARING YOUR HOME FOR THE **BLESSING:**

1) Your home does NOT have to off. Just remember to place be spotless, but should be free of the phone back on the hook clutter on the floor,

2) A table should be prepared where an icon, a candle, a small bowl, holy water and a list of first
