Orthodox Youth Mission Team-- The date for our mission trip for 2023 has been set. We will once again be traveling to Appalachia to participate in an ASP service project from July 8-16, 2023. As a reminder, all Orthodox teens who are currently in 8th grade or above now are eligible to participate. We are also looking for adult leaders (age 25+) and college students who have previously participated in an OYMT trip to be youth leaders. Please write "Registration Fee" in the "Special Instructions to Seller" note. (If you choose this convenient option, please consider paying \$180.25 to cover the online fees.) You may also give your check to an OYMT adult leader at your parish.

- **PLEASE FILL OUT THE FORM AND ALL REQUESTED MEDICAL INFORMATION INCLUDING DOCTOR'S NAME AND PHONE NUMBER, MEDICATIONS, ETC.** The form will allow you to leave these sections blank but this is how we are gathering our emergency information for each team member. *This must be done before the first meeting on Sun. Dec. 4, 2022*
